seek help, emotions and relationships in the family are often at a breaking point. In highly charged situations, it can be very difficult to sift through the dizzying array of recovery services and know whom to



trust. RecoveryLine is a free recovery assistance service providing callers with access and referrals to proven and effective recovery facilities and experienced professionals, including treatment centers that have been featured on major media venues such as A&E and Larry King.

With a single call, people in need can talk to someone who knows the right questions to ask and can begin to assess their situation, creating a list of proven and relevant service referrals, including interventions, detox facilities, residential or outpatient treatment, sober living homes, counselors and therapists, 12-step meetings, sponsorships, spiritual mentoring, shelters, and even food banks. In difficult cases, callers can also talk to a licensed clinician who can perform a more detailed evaluation and make further recommendations.

individualized programs

With treament plans covering both traditional and Christian tracks, clients can choose from an array of inpatient and intensive outpatient programs to meet individual needs and budgets. Encompass programs are

highly structured and can include dual diagnosis treatment for those who are struggling with mental health issues along with drug and alcohol dependencies, gender specific programming, psychological assessments, and psychiatric eval-



uations. These services complement core programming of 12 step groups, individual counseling, psychotherapy, pastoral counseling, marriage counseling, family therapy, group therapy, relapse prevention, employment assistance, temporary sponsorships, exercise (gym memberships) and a variety of recreational outings...all near the beaches of Orange County, California.
